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# Taunton State Hospital Annual Report, 1918

The hospital was attacked by the influenza the last of September, and the epidemic following was the most extensive, severe and fatal in the history of the hospital. The first case developed at the Simeon Borden, Sr., Colony, in the family of our head farmer, Mr. Hiltz. This case was doubtless acquired in the city of Taunton, where the epidemic was raging before

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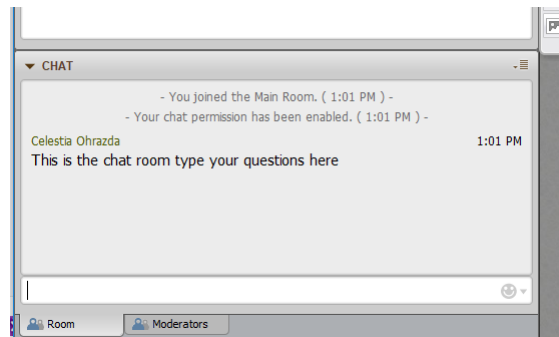
